

Guidelines for E-Poster Presenters (Poster Tour Sessions)

SESSION FORMAT

- Poster tour sessions take place in front of the **E-Poster stations** (screens) in Exhibition. Before your session, please check the program via the **congress app** in the **Posters** tab to confirm which station you are assigned to, as well as the exact date and time of your session.
- Microphones for the moderators and speakers and headsets for the audience will be available for better sound distribution.
- Each presenter has **6 minutes in total**. This includes both time for presentation (4-5 minutes) and Q&A time (1-2 minutes).
- Presenters will talk in front of their E-Posters that they uploaded to the LUPUS 2025 E-Poster Gallery. Before the session, the E-Poster stations will be prepared to show on screen the presentations in your session.
- Please note that printed posters mounted in shifts aim to provide higher visibility for your work and will not be used during Poster Tour sessions. For printed poster guidelines, please visit the [congress website](#).

E-POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- E-Posters must be uploaded before the start of the congress, following the guidelines on the [congress website](#).
- By uploading your E-Poster, you agree to have it published in the official congress proceedings for the duration of 3 months following the LUPUS 2025 Congress.
- The copying and recording of the presented content is prohibited. Presenters are encouraged to indicate in their posters that the presented content shall not be shared or copied.
